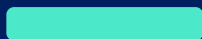

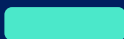

RNS is a **rich learning community** made up of students, teachers and parents from a variety of backgrounds that represent different countries, international heritages and geographic areas. There is a **total of 260 students** comprising **over 47 nationalities**.

RNS requires students to achieve **22 credits to graduate**.

**A student enrolled in the tennis program must maintain a GPA of 2.3 or above to travel for tournaments and any student with a GPA of 2.5 or below will be required to attend study hall until their GPA has improved.
